Lights For Our Church Facade

We have just completed work on the Facade of our Church by lighting the entire Facade with four halogen 600 watt lights to illuminate the entire facade each evening from 6 pm until midnight.

This work was supposed to have been done months ago, but the people who were supposed to do it kept on stalling us off time and time again, and giving us all sorts of promises and excuses. Of course, we just got a little tired of these and brought in our own electricians to do the work. It was completed in two week-ends. And now we can say that the work is completed and the Facade of our church is now lit up in time for this year's great Feast of San Gennaro.

And in keeping with our policy of trying our best to beautify Most Precious Blood, we had the points of our new fence both on Mulberry Street as well as Baxter Street retouched with gold leaf and thus it will be there for years and years to enjoy. Also touched up with Gold Leaf was the lettering over the Mulberry Street Gates as depicted on the Arch entering our property.
